Mr Jeffrey Chan Wah Teck, SC, PPA (P), PPA (E), PBS is a Deputy Solicitor-General at the Attorney-General's Chambers. He read law at the then University of Singapore on a President's Scholarship graduating in 1973 as the Gold Medallist of his class. His many appointments in the Singapore Legal Service included as a DPP, State Counsel, Assistant Registrar, Supreme Court, Magistrate, Director Legal Service MINDEF and head of the Civil and then the International Affairs Division of the Attorney-General's Chambers. He was the first Chief of Staff of the Singapore Legal Service. He retired in 2013 and has been re-employed on contract.

His previous appointments included member of the Military Court of Appeal, the National Committee on Heritage, the Preservation of Monuments Board, the National Archives Board, the Bioethics Advisory Committee and the Law Reform as well as the Professional Affairs Committee of the Singapore Academy of Law. He was also the Chairman of the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law(UNCITRAL) and Chairman of its Working Group on Electronic Commerce. His work included frequent litigation in the courts, legal advice, preparation of legal documents, negotiating international agreements and attending to other international, regional and Commonwealth matters.

Jeffrey Chan was Singapore's Chief Negotiator for the Treaty on Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters as well as the Extradition Treaty with Indonesia and a Member of the ASEAN High Level Legal Experts Group. He was Vice-Chairman of Singapore Red Cross and is a Past President of the Medico-Legal society. Currently he is the Chairman of the UNCITRAL Working Group on Online Dispute Resolution. He is a frequent speaker at different forums locally and abroad on a wide range of legal topics.
