

**Judge Belinda Ang Saw Ean, Supreme Court of Singapore
Chairperson, Singapore Mediation Centre**

Justice Ang was appointed Judicial Commissioner on 1 February 2002, and was appointed Judge of the Supreme Court of Singapore on 2 January 2003. Justice Ang sits as a specialist judge for Admiralty and Arbitration matters as well as in the Finance, Securities, Banking, Complex Commercial cases cluster. Justice Ang took over as Chairperson of the Singapore Mediation Centre (SMC) on 1 September 2011.

Prior to these appointments, she was a lawyer in private practice and held the title of Senior Counsel (appointed in 1998). Justice Ang was a member of the sub-committee on the Review of Arbitration Laws, appointed by the Attorney-General in 1991, that made recommendations on Singapore's laws relating to international commercial arbitrations, and which led to the enactment of the International Arbitration Act (Cap 143). She also completed a mediation workshop and was accredited a SMC mediator. Whilst in practice, Justice Ang was involved in mediations either as Counsel or as Mediator.
