

**Indranee THURAI RAJAH**  
**Senior Minister of State for Law and Finance**  
**Member of Parliament for Tanjong Pagar GRC**

Ms Indranee Rajah is the Senior Minister of State for Law and Finance.

She was educated at Raffles Institution in Singapore, read law at the National University of Singapore before being admitted to the Singapore Bar in 1987. Ms Indranee joined the Singapore office of the UK law firm, Freshfields, in 1987 as a legal associate. A year later, she joined the Litigation department of Drew & Napier where she eventually rose up to Deputy Head of the Dispute Resolution Department, a post she held until October 2012.

Ms Indranee was appointed Senior Counsel by the Chief Justice of Singapore in January 2003. She has had an active practice as a trial lawyer with cases involving cross-border, corporate and commercial disputes as well as international arbitration.

As part of her portfolio at the Ministry of Law, Ms Indranee helmed committees on the review for the law on homicide and promotion of pro bono legal work. She also co-chaired the Committees for Family Justice and the Singapore International Commercial Court.

Ms Indranee has been the Member of Parliament for the Tanjong Pagar Group Representation Constituency (GRC) since 2001. She was elected by Parliament as one of the two Deputy Speakers of Parliament from 2006 to 2011.
