



**Mr Tan Siong Thye**  
**Deputy Attorney-General**

Mr Tan Siong Thye graduated with Bachelor of Law (Honors) from the National University of Singapore in 1979 and obtained his Masters of Law (Merit) from the University College of London under the legal service post graduate scholarship in 1992.

Mr Tan started his legal practice in the Attorney-General's Chambers (AGC) in 1979. In 1986 he was posted to the Subordinate Courts and held various key appointments including Referee of the Small Claim Tribunals, Juvenile Magistrate, and District Judge.

Mr Tan assumed the post of Director, Commercial Affairs Department from 1999 to 2008. Thereafter, he took up appointment as the Chief District Judge of the Subordinate Courts. On 1 October 2013, Mr Tan was appointed as Judicial Commissioner of the Supreme Court, and was subsequently appointed a Supreme Court Judge in July 2014.

Mr Tan assumed office as the Deputy Attorney-General of the Republic of Singapore on 2 February 2015.
