Jennifer Marie is the Deputy Presiding Judge and Registrar of the State Courts (Singapore). She performs both judicial and administrative functions at the State Courts.

Ms Marie graduated from the National University of Singapore with a Bachelor of Laws degree in 1983. Subsequently, she obtained a Master of Laws degree from the University of London in 1990. She joined the Legal Service and was posted to the then Crime Division of the Attorney-General's Chamber as a Deputy Public Prosecutor and State Counsel.

Prior to being posted to the State Courts in 2011, she was a Chief Prosecutor at the Criminal Justice Division of the Attorney-General's Chambers.

She was appointed a Senior Counsel in 2010 and was awarded the Public Administration Medal (Silver) in 1999 for her invaluable contributions to the administration of justice. She has been appointed to be on the Singapore Mediation Centre Panel of Principal Mediators and also the Healthcare Mediator of the Singapore Mediation Centre. She is also a member of the Executive Board of the International Consortium for Court Excellence and has delivered a number of papers at international conferences and meetings on the State Courts journey towards greater organisational excellence in the administration of justice. She is also an Adjunct Professor at the Law Faculty of the National University of Singapore.
